- 6 Fairview Lawn Cemetery • Titanic Grave Site
- 7 Art Gallery of Nova Scotia • Province House • Halifax Boardwalk

TOUR GUIDELINES

- Tour route operates on a 15-30 minute frequency.
- If you choose to complete an additional tour loop, you may be requested to disembark and re-queue at STOP 1 to allow new guests to board.
- Buses come in a variety of colours.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Remain seated while bus is in motion.
- Please wait for direction from your guide when entering and exiting the bus.
- Please obey traffic regulations while touring Halifax.

NOTE!

- Local Clocks Display Atlantic Daylight Time (ADT)
- Guests must be aware of the ship's all on board (AOB) time as the tour operator is not responsible for guests who miss their AOB time.
- While on route guests may encounter long lines at stops.
- Wheelchair/ Stroller – one each per Double Decker
- Hand-Baggage allowed, no big size bag or suitcases are allowed
- Only service animals are allowed.
- Infants must sit on laps.
- Seating is on a first come first serve basis.

DISCLAIMER

Due to traffic issues, public holidays, weather conditions, cruise ship arrivals and unforeseen circumstances, there might be sudden changes in the route or on the schedule. In "normal times" Halifax is a busy city, especially during special events, summer holidays and at weekends. Traffic congestion and road closures - may cause delays, reduced frequency and changes to the route. We'll do all we can to provide a smooth and frequent service!
